What's the difference between a Prototype and an IDP

Prototype

If you select Prototype, you will not receive a plan or adoption agreements. You will be able to submit an order for a Prototype Supporting Forms Package (Summary Plan Description, Notice to Interested Parties, Resolution, Administrative Forms, Index, and 5307).

Only select Prototype if you have already purchased the corresponding Prototype Plan document. The fees for the combined Plan & Trust plus Standardized & Non-Standardized Adoptions Agreements range from \$2,500-\$4,500. IDP/Volume Submitter

Select IDP to submit orders for individually designed documents (including volume submitter).
